Petitioner seeks relief from permit condition violations for Natural Gas Microturbines under Permits to Operate PTO-21-00022, PTO-21-00023, and PTO-21-00025. Petitioner will use the variance period to work with the turbine manufacturer to determine cause, remedy and test the microturbine fuel injectors.

*On September 16, 2021, Governor Newsom signed AB 361 which amends the Brown Act to allow meeting bodies subject to the Brown Act to meet via teleconference during a proclaimed state of emergency in accordance with teleconference procedures established by AB 361 rather than under the Brown Act's more narrow standard rules for participation in a meeting by teleconference. The Monterey County Health Officer has issued a recommendation for social distancing in legislative body meetings, so the first meeting after September 30, 2021, may be held without making findings. If the Board desires to continue to meet remotely via teleconference after that first meeting, the Board is required to make certain findings under AB 361 no later than 30 days after the first teleconference meeting held pursuant to AB 361, and every 30 days thereafter. Members of the public that wish to participate in the MBARD Hearing Board meeting may do so by joining the Zoom Webinar ID.
