Agricultural Waste Burning	Fires used in agricultural operations. An agricultural operation is the growing of crops, the raising of fowl, animals, or bees as a gainful occupation.	All year on permissive burn days	No	Yes	Call 1(800) 225-2876 (1-800-CAL-BURN) after 4:00 PM
Backyard Burns	Burns for disposing of dry vegetation grown on the premises of a single- or two-family residence	Only on permissive burn days during the backyard burn season (December 1 through April 30)	No	Possibly; call to verify	Call 1(800) 225-2876 (1-800-CAL-BURN) after 4:00 PM
Development Burns	Burns for disposing of dry vegetation grown on a property being developed for commercial or residential purposes	Only on permissive burn days during the backyard burn season (December 1 through April 30). Air District authorization is required.	Yes	Yes	Call the number or visit the website listed on your Air District Smoke Management Permit.
Prescribed Burns	<p><b>Types of Prescribed Burns Include:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Development</li> <li>- Fire Hazard Abatement</li> <li>- Forest Management</li> <li>- Levee, Reservoir, and Ditch Maintenance</li> <li>- Mechanized Burning</li> <li>- Range Improvement</li> <li>- Right-of-Way Clearing conducted by public entities or utilities</li> <li>- Watershed Management</li> <li>- Wildlife Habitat Improvement</li> <li>- Wildland Vegetation Management</li> </ul>	All year on permissive burn days. Recreational, Ceremonial, Religious, Educational, Cooking and Warming Fires	Fires that have a purpose other than disposing of the material burned	Any day of the year	No	Check with Fire District	You may burn fires of this nature on any day of the year
