Accepting Applications for Diesel Engine & Equipment Replacement Grant Programs Monterey, California – January 22, 2019

The Monterey Bay Air Resources District (MBARD) is pleased to announce that it is now accepting applications for grant funds through the Diesel Engine & Equipment Replacement Grant Programs. “MBARD implements the Diesel Engine & Equipment Replacement Grant Programs in partnership with the California Air Resources Board to increase the turnover of high polluting equipment to reduce harmful diesel exhaust emissions,” said Richard Stedman, Air Pollution Control Officer. “Each year we get an overwhelming response to the call for applications.”

Grants cannot be used to satisfy existing air quality mandates or legal requirements; however, they can be applied to equipment that complies several years in advance of state regulations. Eligible equipment categories include the following:

- Off-Road Equipment Replacement
- Off-Road Engine Repower
- Marine Vessels
- Agricultural Irrigation Pumps

The deadline for submitting an application is March 18, 2019.
