Petitioner seeks relief from violation of condition 3 of permitted emergency generators 11327, 12111, 14313 and 14314. Petitioner will use the variance period to operate standby and emergency generators to provide continuity of power on campus during various interruptions of services needed to replace and test main electrical feeders to Porter and Kresge Colleges.

On September 16, 2021, Governor Newsom signed AB 361 which amends the Brown Act to allow meeting bodies subject to the Brown Act to meet via teleconference during a proclaimed state of emergency in accordance with teleconference procedures established by AB 361 rather than under the Brown Act's more narrow standard rules for participation in a meeting by teleconference. The Monterey County Health Officer has issued a recommendation for social distancing in legislative body meetings, so the first meeting after September 30, 2021, may be held without making findings. If the Board desires to continue to meet remotely via teleconference after that first meeting, the Board is required to make certain findings under AB 361 no later than 30 days after the first teleconference meeting held pursuant to AB 361, and every 30 days thereafter. Members of the public that wish to participate in the MBARD Hearing Board meeting may do so by joining the Zoom Webinar ID. Persons who wish to address the Board for public comment or on an item on the agenda are encouraged to submit comments in writing to MBARD by emailing sirie@mbard.org by 5:00 pm on Monday, November 29, 2021. Comments will be distributed to the Board before the meeting. Members of the public participating via Zoom will be muted during the proceedings and may be unmuted to speak during public comment after requesting and receiving recognition by the Chair.
